

Off Licence

Section 17 to 20, 64 and 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

007/OFF/9031/2022

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Man O War Vineyards Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **725 Man O'War Bay Road WAIHEKE ISLAND Auckland**, and known as **Man O War Vineyards**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day. Except that alcohol may be sold on or delivered from the premises at any time on Easter Sunday if it is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made on the premises or from produce harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
- (b) **Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:**

Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 11.00pm
- (c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers immediately adjacent to any alcohol that is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
- (d) No intoxicated persons may be allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
- (e) Appropriate signage regarding the restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons must be prominently displayed at each entry, and adjacent to every point of sale.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licenses, this licence continues in force—

- (a) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed.

This licence expires at the close of 14th September 2024 unless renewed.
