OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), FOLEY WINES LIMITED is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 13 Waihopai Valley Road Waihopai, Marlborough District and known as "Grove Mill Winery", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol, as a sample of up to 35ml, for consumption on the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day, or at any time after 11.00pm on any day and before 6.00am on the next day.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold or delivered on the following days and during the following hours: Monday to Sunday 8.00am to 10.00pm Remote Sales -At any time on any day
- (c) The remote sale of alcohol may be made at any time on any day, however the days and hours within which alcohol that has been sold may be delivered is restricted, as set out in conditions (a) above.
- (d) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition of sales to intoxicated persons.
- (e) The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.
- (f) The licensee, when conducting phone, mail, internet sales (remote sales) must ensure that all the requirements under Section 59 of the Act relating to remote sales are complied with.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Waihopai Valley Road is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued;
- if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, (b) either-
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed: or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
